

Most of the Graphic Organizers included can be used with ANY podcast.

The very first graphic organizer can be used specifically with the Podcast "But Why."



I have found all of the podcasts free on several different Podcast apps. You can also search online for these Podcasts if that is easier.

Podcasts would also be great to use as a Media Source, and then find a paired text for the students to read. Have them write an essay or participate in an academic discussion based on the topic.

At the bottom of most graphic organizers, the students can rate the Podcast episode using a specific number of stars.
